This document provides you with concise access information (including a test username & password, and verification process) which can be used to verify that your system is correctly configured to access HP Virtual Labs (HPVL) before your class begins.

- The username and password are for pre-class verification use only, and only provide access to a basic access verification lab.
- When your class begins, your instructor will provide you with your course-specific username and password which provide access to your actual course lab(s) in HPVL.

HPVL Access Pre-Course Test Procedure

1. Click the [HPVL_Access_Test](#) link.
 - a. Accept any downloads or networking and certificate windows, which should only happen the first time.
 - b. An “F5 Application Access” IE application will open on your local PC’s desktop.
 - c. Within this window a web page will appear, with the message “**You have successfully accessed the HPVL Test Lab**” displayed.

2. To complete the pre-course test:
 - a. Click the “Exit” button at the bottom of the HPVL lab page, to exit the lab.
 - b. Click “Yes” on the “Do you want to close this window” popup. This will cause the webtop window to also close.
 - c. Click “Logout” in the upper right of the screen, below “Welcome to HP Virtual Labs”, in your browser window at <https://labs.usa.hp.com>.
